FACT 1

1 in 10 college students have suicidal ideation.

FACT 2

1100 college students commit suicide each year.

FACT 3

Suicide is the second leading cause of death for people ages 15-19.

Know the Warning Signs

Some of these risk factors can be indicators someone may be suicidal:

Mood: depression, anxiety, disinterested, shameful, anger/agitation Dialogue: talk about killing oneself, talk about hopelessness, talk about feeling trapped, talk about being a burden to others Behaviors: increased use of drugs and alcohol, isolation from loved ones, obsessive thoughts about death, saying goodbye to people

How To Respond

- Become available: "I'm here for you."
- Ask about their emotions: "I've noticed you've been distant lately. How have you been doing?"
- Listen without judgment : Allow the other to express their feelings.
- Suggest seeking help from healthcare professionals
- Stay with them (if possible); Don't leave them alone.
- Take action: remove, weapons, pills, or other harmful objects.

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
